Warnings

Check the warning systems in your area:

- NOAA Weather Radio (NWR)
- Siren (Tornado, Tsunami, Hurricane, etc)

Watch: A watch is issued when there is a potential for a natural hazard to occur. During a watch, monitor local weather reports or the radio for more information.

Warning: A warning is issued when a natural hazard is occurring or is imminent. Depending on the hazard, you may be directed to take shelter.

Shelters

If an evacuation is issued:

We will check the FEMA app to see if shelters are available in the area we are traveling to or we will tune into local media if possible to learn if shelters have been set up.
